

GENERAL COMPETITIONS RULES

1. In order that three prizes may be awarded in the competitions it will be necessary to have at least four entries.
2. If a competitor is not present when called to perform in the competition he/she may be disqualified.
3. Competitors must not communicate with the adjudicator before or during competitions.
4. Any communications with the adjudicator(s) must be made through the Competitions Officer or his/her deputy.
5. Responsibility will not be accepted for entries lost, delayed, mislaid or damaged in the post or insufficiently stamped.
6. All entry forms will automatically become the property of the Pan Celtic International Committee and will not be returned.
7. The Pan Celtic International Committee will not be responsible for any loss or damage to competitors' property.
8. The decision of the Pan Celtic shall be final and binding in respect of all matters relating to the Competitions and this shall be accepted by each competitor.
9. Each competitor on entering the competition acknowledges that they have read the rules and agree to accept and abide by the rules as set out.
10. Entry forms should reach the Competitions Officer by the deadline for entries, March 1st.
11. Entries must be submitted on Official Entry Forms. Ensure that Entry Fees, S.A.E., and all relevant documents (Translations/Lyrics/Music etc.) are enclosed.
12. Flash photography is not allowed during competitions.
13. The use of Video/Camcorders is prohibited during performances at competitions.
